The Diamond King is a short video game opera about a mad king's rise to power, a hero's quest to stop him, star-crossed lovers, and the eventual destruction of the earth. The premise is inspired by video games such as *Earthbound*, the *Tales* series, and *The Legend of Zelda: Majora's Mask*. In fact, for the text, I use my own writing as well as a quote from *Majora's Mask*. In addition to the mixed percussion in this piece, I introduce two new instruments, the Screamer and the Bowed Spectacle.

In the Promenade, the characters Mike and Boris go for a walk in the park to try out their newfound powers: the ability to turn people into diamond. Mike is crowned as the Diamond King, and the hero Derek resolves to defeat him. The Waltz creates a sonic landscape with various percussion instruments, setting up the scene for the forest that surrounds the new Diamond King's castle: a place where our false protagonist Derek meets his fate. Helen, Derek's lover, laments his death in the Aria after just having met him. By the end of the opera, the Diamond King and his followers manage to diamondize the moon, which then, through their greed, comes crashing down into the earth with all its mass.


